Common Side Effects and Risks:

Mood swings are the most common side effect (70%), whereas hot flashes occur approximately 10% of the time. These side effects typically abate soon after treatment ends. Visual disturbances, including blurred or double vision and light sensitivity generally are uncommon (<2%). Whenever visual disturbances are identified, it is prudent to stop treatment. Less specific side effects include breast tenderness, pelvic discomfort and nausea (2%-5%).

The risk of multiple gestation is increased to approximately 8% overall. There is no evidence that Clomid treatment increases the risk of birth defects.
